## **THE STUDY TOPIC WILL BE *GOSPEL OF LUKE***

The Presiding Bishop Michael Curry has recommended the study of Luke's Gospel as a Lenten study for the Episcopal community examining its relevance the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. The weekly study will be framed around topics such as:

An Introduction to the Gospel of Luke and the audience to which Luke was writing, and its most important themes:

- ⊕ The context of women in the Gospel of Luke;
- ⊕ How issues related to wealth are addressed in Luke's Gospel;
- ⊕ How we read Luke's Gospel in the context of giving, and how Christ frees us to give freely
- ⊕ Luke's approach to spreading the good news of Jesus and what that means for 21<sup>st</sup> century Christians.
