



Nevadans for the Common Good Postcard Campaign

The federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) has allocated \$440 million to Clark County to assist with the housing needs caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Nevadans for the Common Good (NCG) is undertaking a postcard campaign to support a plan to develop the Clark County response to the housing crisis. NCG representatives have been in conversation with members of the County Commission and their staffs to develop a coordinated community system for citizens to use in applying for housing assistance.

NCG is requesting that member institutions like Grace in the Desert send postcards to Commissioner Ross Miller to show that there is broad community support for a coordinated approach to assisting renters and landlords affected by the economic downturn.
