

Letter from the Diocesan Chancellor Regarding Updated COVID Protocols

The Chancellor of the Diocese has sent a letter recommending that all churches in southern Nevada take more stringent steps to protect parishioners in light of the increased incidence of COVID-19 infections.

A copy of the letter will be available for those of you who attend the services on Sunday July 25th. As you know, we have already reinstated some of the earlier protocols; i.e., wearing masks, but we must take additional actions.

1. Everyone must continue to wear masks while in church or on the church grounds until further notice.
2. Travis Lohmann, our organist, will play one or two verses of the hymns listing in the bulletin, but we **MUST NOT** sing.
3. If you are not from the same household, please maintain a distance of at least 3 feet or, if possible, 6 feet from the next closest parishioner.
4. As a reminder, you must not attend a service if you have exhibited any upper respiratory symptoms or have come in contact with anyone with COVID.
5. If you test positive for COVID after having attended a service, you must notify the church office.

Thank you for your understanding. We must all do what we can to prevent the spread of this disease.
