WORSHIP

Participants are needed to assist in the following ways for our worship services:

ACOLYTES

Serve at the altar by assisting the Presider and Deacon, carrying the cross or candles, and many other tasks as needed by the Priest

ALTAR GUILD

Those responsible for preparing the altar for each Eucharist

CHOIR MEMBERS

Music is a part of our Saturday night contemporary service and traditional service at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday

GREETERS AND USHERS

Serve at each service to welcome visitors, assist with the offering collection, and assist congregation members to the altar for the Eucharist

CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Participants are needed to assist with the various educational ministries offered at Grace in the Desert

ADULT EDUCATION CLASSES

Topics of interest for adults are presented before the 10:30 a.m. Sunday service

EFM—EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY

EFM is a "distance-learning program for adult Christian formation through theological education and reflection offered by the Beecken Center of the School of Theology at the University of the South, Sewanee, Tennessee."

CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL

Using a defined curriculum, teachers are needed to lead Sunday School classes

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

During the summer, this program is offered to members of Grace in the Desert as well as to children in the surrounding neighborhood

SERVICE & FELLOWSHIP

Grace in the Desert provides many opportunities for fellowship and service to members of the parish as well as those who live in our community

LOAVES AND FISHES

Food donated to this program supports the Epicenter on the Parkway Food Bank behind Christ Church on Maryland Parkway

FOYER GROUPS

Groups of eight individuals deepen their community connection by hosting and sharing meals in their homes

CARING HANDS

This ministry is parishioners assisting parishioners who are in need of short term special care

HOSTING

Organizing and providing light snacks for a fellowship hour after the Sunday 10:30 service

REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT

Grace in the Desert works with Catholic Charities to provide resettlement assistance for legal refugees.

RECOVERY

Recovery ministries link those with addictions to recovery services and Grace in the Desert hosts recovery group meetings for AA and GA

PRAYER CHAIN

Provides spiritual support and healing for parishioners, their families and friends through prayer
